It is a great pleasure for the University of Alicante to host this event in our campus to discuss about *Urban Challenges and Sustainable Technological Revolution* as important aspects of Regional Science. It is also an honour for me to be the chair of this conference in which most of my colleagues contribute with excellent research.

On behalf of the European Regional Science Association, I am very happy to welcome you all to our 62nd European Congress on ‘Urban Challenges and Sustainable Technological Revolution’ in the splendid city of Alicante, and also online.

This will be my last Congress acting as the President of ERSA, starting in 2019 in Lyon, followed by two online Congresses due to COVID, then Pecs in 2022, and now Alicante. I am very happy that the ERSA Council could already decide that Terceira (Portugal, Azores) is the next venue, and that proposals for further future congresses will be discussed in Alicante. 

## VENUES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALICANTE










### 'Salón de Grados' German Bernácer Building (building 36)




